

Winter Emergency Parking



Police Chief Mortenson would like to remind all Elko New Market residents of the Winter Emergency Parking Regulations.

City Ordinance (**Parking Regulations: 7-2-3 (B)**) prohibits parking on any City street until the street has been cleaned curb to curb during a winter snow emergency. A winter snow emergency is when the national weather service forecast accumulation is two or more inches of snow. A violation of the winter parking ordinance is a **Misdemeanor** and may result in a citation and/or towing of the vehicle.

The term "Emergency" means a condition created on City streets because of the presence of snow, freezing rain, sleet or ice thereon, or other natural phenomenon which creates hazardous road conditions or impedes or is likely to impede the free movement of fire, health, police, emergency or other vehicular traffic, when the same has been duly declared.
