### Donation of LUCAS Chest Compression System

At the March 26, 2015 City Council Meeting, Jodi Muelken (pictured at the left), President of the Elko New Market Fire Relief Association presented the City with a LUCAS Chest Compression System. This system was purchased with funds donated by the Elko New Market Fire Relief Association.

The LUCAS Chest Compression System is designed to help improve outcomes of sudden cardiac arrest victims and improve operations for

medical responders.

The LUCAS delivers uninterrupted compressions at a consistent rate, which helps the paramedics as performing manual CPR is difficult and tiring.

The portability of this equipment also allows the firefighters or paramedics to leave LUCAS on the patient while transporting to a medical facility.

### City Seeking Fire Fighters

The City of Elko New Market is accepting applications for Paid On-Call Fire Fighters. Individual will be responsible for performing fire prevention, protection and medical service work involving response to fire alarms, medical, other emergency calls and related work as required.

Minimum qualifications include 18 years of age, high school diploma or equivalent, ability to complete First Responder and Fire Fighter I

Certification within 12 months of employment, valid Minnesota Class D drivers license, and must be able to pass a pre-employment physical exam. The application deadline is 4:30 p.m. on April 24, 2015.

## Police Officers Train at Regional Training Facility

How many of you knew that there is a "State of the Art" training facility available for public safety personnel to train at right here in Scott County? It's true, and the facility is located in the City of Jordan.

For several years now, officers from the Elko New Market Police Department have been utilizing this facility to train in the use of: Firearms, Use of Force Techniques, Use of Non-Lethal Weapons, and a Driving Simulation.

Officers shoot quarterly at the two outdoor ranges. Each range is equipped with a 25 yard paved surface. One range accommodates shooting from up to 200 yards when officers are training with the AR-15 rifles. Both ranges have a roof that allows officers to train in all types of weather conditions.

Inside the facility there are several rooms officers utilize for scenario based training. One room is completely outlined with padded mats. This room is used when practicing "Defensive Tactics" techniques. Elko New Market Police Officers train with the Scott County Sheriff's Office annually in the area of Use of Force.

The facility has been upgraded in the past few years to provide police officers in Scott County with one of the best training facilities in the state. The Regional Training Facility is utilized by several law enforcement agencies as well as fire departments statewide. But for Scott County Law Enforcement Agencies it's free of charge to use.

## Spring Yard Cleanup

Want to improve your curb appeal and do your part for clean water at the same time? This spring, if you have leaves and grass to remove from your yard, compost your leaves or put them in your yard waste bin for pickup. Leaves and grass clippings blown into the street look messy, clog storm drains, and add unwanted nutrients to our waterways.

**Do's:** (1) Compost your leaves on your own property. (2) Leave grass clippings on your lawn to act as fertilizer. (3) Hire a yard service that properly disposes of leaves.

**Don'ts:** (1) Blow leaves or grass clippings onto the street. (2) Dump leaves or grass into a ditch or storm drain. (3) Burn yard waste.
