In addition, a Special Election will be held for Councilmember serving 2 Years of a 4 Year Term to fill a vacancy, this term expires December 31, 2016.

Water Conservation

WITH SUMMER UPON US, PLEASE ADHERE TO THE WATERING CONSERVATION MEASURES.

After experiencing a colder and wetter than normal spring and start of summer, it appears that "our normal summer" has finally come upon us. With this, residents are now watering their lawns more frequently. Please remember the City of Elko New Market does have a city code regarding the watering of lawns. Any resident found in violation of the city code will receive a written notice from the Police Department, further violations could result in a citation which is a **Misdemeanor**. Below is the city code for watering lawns. This city code along with all of the city's codes can be found on the City website.

9-1-10: CONSERVATION AND EMERGENCY MEASURES:

A. Conservation Measures:

1. Odd/Even Restriction: Use of the city water supply system for lawn or garden sprinkling or other irrigation shall be limited to an odd/even

schedule corresponding to the property address effective each year from May 1 to September 30. Lawn or garden sprinkling or other irrigation is not permitted between the hours of eleven o'clock (11:00) a.m. and six o'clock (6:00) p.m.

2. Exception: The watering of new seed or sod for a period of two (2) weeks from the date of seeding or sodding shall be excepted from the odd-even water use restrictions provided under subsection A1 of this section, but not the restriction on hours of sprinkling or irrigation. This exception for seeded or sodded areas shall not apply to previously established areas of the same lot.

B. Emergency Restrictions: Whenever the city council determines it in the public interest, the city council may, by resolution, further limit the use, times and hours during which water may be used from the city water supply system by giving notice by publication or by posting in the city hall and at such public places as the city council may direct.

Attention Residents: Delinquent Utility Billing

This is a reminder to residents that City Code states that any utility billing not paid in full within 30 days is considered delinquent and is subject to certification to property taxes in November of each year.

Utility Billing System: Forms Required

Please be aware that the City requires written documentation to make any changes in the utility billing system.

There are multiple Utility Billing Service Forms available on the City's website at www.ci.enm.mn.us under "City Forms." The online forms are the most convenient forms available. Once submitted, the information is

emailed to the Utility Billing Department for processing.



Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4)

A municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) is a system of conveyances (roads with drainage systems, municipal streets, curbs, gutters, ditches, man-made channels, storm drains) that is owned or operated by a public body, such as a county, city, or township. A storm sewer system is not connected with a wastewater treatment system. Stormwater, and the pollutants traveling with it, go directly through the storm sewer into nearby surface water.

The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency implements a stormwater permit program for

MS4s. The City of Elko New Market is in the process of complying with the latest permit that was issued in 2013. The purpose of the stormwater program is to reduce the amount of sediment and pollution that enters surface water from storm sewer systems to the maximum extent practicable. Stormwater discharges associated with these storm sewer systems are regulated through a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit (NPDES). The primary goal of the permit is to improve water quality by reducing pollutants in stormwater discharges.
