

- Daycare visits throughout the city.

Calls for service remained relatively the same in 2013 from 2012. Majority of the calls for service are public service calls, calls that are not Part 1 or Part 2 crimes.


There was a 12% increase in Total Incidents Handled in 2013 from 2012. A portion of this increase was due to the increased involvement of Elko New Market Police Officers in all areas of service but specifically in areas of City Code Violations/Ordinances, an increase in traffic stops as officers worked Toward Zero Death (TZD) shifts, a growing number of residents requesting “house watch” of their homes, involvement in Community Value Base Police activities, and public assist calls.

Part 1/Part 2 Crimes




Part 1 crimes: Crimes against Persons – Murder, Sexual Assault, Robbery, Aggravated Assault and Property Crimes – Burglary, Theft & Theft from Motor Vehicle, Auto Theft, and Arson.

Part 2 crimes: Other Crimes against Persons, Public Disorder Crimes, White Collar Crimes, Weapons Offenses, Stolen Property, and Drug & Alcohol Related Offenses.


There was a significant decrease in Part 1 Crimes in 2013 from 2012 mainly in crimes of theft, theft from motor vehicle and burglary. The reduction of these property crimes could be contributed to an increased presence of neighborhood patrol by officers and the vigilance of residents “being aware of what’s going” in their neighborhoods. As a result of the latter, the Police Department responded to an increased number of “Suspicion” calls in 2013.
